

Privacy Policy

It is the aim of West Cumbria Mining, and any of the Company's group companies and the officers, directors, employees, shareholders or consultants of any of them that all persons whose personal data is processed by West Cumbria Mining shall at all times be confident that their privacy is respected, and that due care is taken regarding his or her personal data.

1 General

- 1.1 West Cumbria Mining Limited (registration number 07144109) and West Cumbria Mining Holdings Limited (registration number 07143398) are the data controllers for the processing carried out by us or on our behalf. This means that we determine the purpose of and means for the processing of your personal data, i.e. why and how we process the data.
- 1.2 West Cumbria Mining will comply with all data protection laws incorporated into UK law that control the collection and use of data relating to individuals ("personal data") as well as with this privacy policy. The purpose of this privacy policy is to set out the principles governing the use of personal data you give to us, or we obtain about you.
- 1.3 This privacy policy will be revised regularly, and any subsequent changes will be published on our website in this area. This version of the privacy policy was last reviewed during April 2018.

2 Data we may collect from you

- 2.1 Personal data, including data such as names and addresses which you provide to West Cumbria Mining, may be processed manually as well as by computers.
- 2.2 **Visitors to our website**
 - 2.2.1 An IP address is a unique number which makes it possible to identify a user's connection to the Internet and it is automatically provided by your web browser each time you view a website. Any visit to the West Cumbria Mining website may lead to registration of the IP address used for such access. We also use IP addresses to measure the use of West Cumbria Mining's webpages. Such measurement may include:
 - 2.2.2 Monitoring/collecting information as to how you use the site to help West Cumbria Mining to improve the site
 - 2.2.3 to personalise your experience by tailoring the content you see
 - 2.2.4 to optimise your user experience
 - 2.2.5 to determine frequency of use
 - 2.2.6 to perform statistical analysis of data collected.

2.3 Use of Cookies

- 2.3.1 This site may use "cookies," which are small data files stored on your computer or another computer for use with your web browser software. Cookies are used on this site to provide the user with access to functions available on the site such as registering for updates, requesting information and submitting enquiries. - 2.3.2 By accepting the Terms of Use as well as by accessing and using the website, you consent to the use of the above stated cookies. You may also consent to our use of cookies by the settings you have made in your web browser. Please note that without cookies, the functionality of the site may be impaired.

2.4 Other stakeholders

- 2.4.1 Other stakeholders include job applicants, former employees, and third parties, as well as individuals contacting West Cumbria Mining via social media.
- 2.4.2 Any personal data collected from other stakeholders will be processed in line with this policy, and the purpose it was originally collected for, and held securely. Please see section 3. Examples of personal data held for other stakeholders are:
- Name
 - Contact details
 - IP address
- 2.4.3 Individuals who submit an interest in working at West Cumbria Mining will have additional data stored, such as which role they are interested in, in order to fulfil their request to register such an interest.

As per the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), data collected must not be kept for longer than it is required. The personal data we collect about other stakeholders will be deleted when no longer required, unless there is a lawful basis to process particular data, or consent has been received to store the data.

3 How we use your data

- 3.1 Your personal data will only be used for the purposes indicated when you submit the data, or to fulfil our legal obligations, or as detailed (below) under this privacy policy. Should we need to process your data for a new purpose we will contact you prior to the processing activity.
- 3.2 We may use personal information in the following ways:
- 3.2.1 To ensure efficiencies and monitor use of our website as per section 2.2
 - 3.2.2 To administer any request from you
 - 3.2.3 To administer any actions needed regarding any agreements with you
 - 3.2.4 Marketing and customer follow-up
 - 3.2.5 Sales/product development, all as determined and applicable by West Cumbria Mining. By submitting personal data, you agree and consent to be bound by the terms outlined in this Privacy Policy and in the Terms of Use.
 - 3.2.6 To comply with regulatory requirements
 - 3.2.7 For business analysis

- 3.3 Personal data will be securely stored on our servers in the majority of cases. Should there be a need to disclose your data elsewhere we will do so after checking the security measures in place. See section 4.
- 3.4 This privacy notice does not cover any links that may be posted within this site linking to other websites. We encourage you to read the privacy statements on the other websites you visit.

4 Disclosure of your data

- 4.1 West Cumbria Mining may provide your personal data to third parties such as a partner or investor in order to fulfil the purpose for which they were collected. The data provided by you might be exported to other parties of the West Cumbria Mining Group and/or business partners located in countries within, or outside of, the European Union and the European Economic Area.
- 4.2 Where data needs to be exported outside of the West Cumbria Mining Group, and the European Economic Area, suitable contracts will be drawn up to maintain a level of security equivalent to the GDPR of the data.
